About The Opportunity

We are seeking an **Artistic Director** with an imaginative vision, committed to achieving artistic excellence, advancing masked theatre as a contemporary art form, and furthering Odyssey's impact, and engagement with audiences and communities. The Artistic Director reports to the Board of Directors, while collaborating closely with the General Manager.

Key Responsibilities

- **Shape the vision** -- Articulate a compelling artistic vision to guide the company and advance masked and physical theatre in Canada
- **Curate** – Plan and oversee seasons featuring a major production, a digital mask resource centre,, training, new play creation, and community engagement activities
- **Create** – Undertake your artistic work to further the Company's mandate
- **Champion New Work** -- Promote the creation original plays for masked theatre
- **Build creative teams** – Oversee the hiring of artistic staff
- **Support Community** – Build key relationships with diverse artists, audiences, and the public.
